All members are required to volunteer a minimum of 12 hours per family (Affiliate 6hrs, Junior 3-4hrs) during the 2023-2024 skating season. Volunteer hours (this does not include donations) will be tracked using SignUp.com. At the end of the season, if you have not completed all 12 hours, you will have to pay \$10 for each hour remaining before you can register for the 2024-2025 season. Affiliate members receive club rates but no other discounts or free sessions, no senior or wall recognition and may perform only their solo at the Annual Ice Show (may not participate in group, senior or opening number). **In addition each skating family must participate in fundraising and pay a hospitality fee as set forth on the back of this form. Affiliate members pay half of the fundraising fee and \$25 hospitality fee. Junior members pay \$15 hospitality but no fundraising fee.**

Fundraising & Hospitality Fee Requirement

The Skating Club of CNY is managed strictly by volunteers and strives to provide all skaters with a positive experience. In order to continue having the club absorb increases in our ice costs without raising ice fees, we need **every** club member's participation in fundraising. Fundraising is what ultimately keeps the club running.

The goal is to have two mandatory fundraisers this year (in addition to the competition held in March). The first fundraiser for the 2023-2024 skating year is a cash raffle and every member family is required to participate. The second fundraiser is TBD (more info to follow).

The cash raffle will work as follows: Members will pay \$100 and will receive 20 raffle tickets (*Affiliate Members pay \$50 / 10 raffle tickets - No hospitality fee*) which they may sell to recoup the cost. You may sell additional tickets if you choose. Tickets can be sold throughout the rest of 2023. Members must return all the ticket stubs by January 10, 2024 to be included in the raffle. On, or around, January 10, 2024 we will draw three winning tickets. The grand prize is \$500 cash, 2nd prize \$200 and 3rd prize is \$100.

In addition, we require that each member family pay an annual fee of \$25 to support our hospitality room. In the past, we asked our members to donate food for our judge hospitality room for our test sessions and the Skate Challenge. Rather than continue to ask members to donate to the hospitality room, we are requiring each member family to donate \$25 towards hospitality which will be used to purchase all items. **The \$25 fee is due with the first \$100 fundraising payment, for a total due of \$125.**

Club members pay \$125 and collect 20 raffle tickets (at club desk)

Affiliate members pay \$75 and collect 10 raffle tickets (at club desk)

Junior members pay \$15 hospitality fee only
