General policy governing club sessions

If you are a less experienced skater, please be extra careful to stay aware
of other skaters and to look ahead of where you are skating to see what
others are doing or are about to do.


- If you are an experienced skater, please be patient with the less experienced skaters. Remember – you were new to freestyle at one time, too.
- Please be understanding if someone gets in your way.




Other things to remember




- 1. Don't stand around talking on the ice (keep moving).
- 2. If you fall, get up quickly.
- 3. Follow ice diagram when practicing jumps and spins.
- 4. Look before skating away from the boards.
- 5. Do not skate to closely to another skater.

Right of Way policy



- 1. The skater wearing an orange or yellow vest or belt has the right of way. Please stay aware of which skater is doing their routine and do your best to stay clear of their pattern. Please wear the vest or belt when you play your music to help other skaters know you are skating your routine.
- 2. Only one skater on the ice should be wearing the vest.
- 3. Skaters taking a lesson have the right of way over general skaters in the session.
- 4. Skaters on the harness also have the right away. Please be careful of the harness area.





Music policy for club sessions

- 1. All skaters and coaches need to put their name on the white board for a music request.
- 2. The white board will distinguish between lesson requests on the left side and non-lesson requests on the right side.
- 3. If there are requests on both sides of the board, two lessons may play their music and then a non lesson request will be played. This order will be followed if there are several coaches and skaters requesting music during a session.

Music policy for club sessions (cont.)

- 4. Non lesson skaters will have a maximum of two music requests per session.
- 5. There will be no starting over of music.
- 6. Skaters must wear a vest when their music is playing.
